**COVID-19 - PHASE ONE -- MASS DIRECTIVES** (effective 5/19/2020)

## Mass Resumes at 25% Church Capacity

- The faithful remain dispensed from the obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and holy days of obligation.
- Only 42 people will be permitted to attend Mass at OLMC (& 36 in Hall); no Mass at OLPH at this time.
- Please consider choosing a weekday Mass if you are able; this will allow those who can ONLY attend Mass on Saturday or Sunday the opportunity.

#### Parishioners:

- should only attend one Mass per week to allow an opportunity for all parishioners to attend Mass.
- must register in advance for the Mass that they
  wish to attend; a link will be available on our
  website and Facebook page. We are using
  EVENTBRITE. Each family member attending the
  Mass needs to be registered.
- must wear a mask & should bring hand sanitizer.
- must maintain **6 feet of distance**, unless you are with members of your family.
- will be **escorted** to a designated pew by ushers.
- please arrive 20 minutes prior to start of Mass to allow ushers time to check names & seat.
- enter church from the main entrance. No entry allowed from side doors near the altar. The wheelchair ramp entry may only be used by those needing assistance.
- No missals/choir/hymnals at this time.
- No presentation of the gifts.
- No physical contact of non-family members.
- No altar servers will be present.
- One lector per Mass.
- Seating is limited to designated open pews.
- Collection baskets will be available in vestibule for you to place your contribution when you enter church.

### **Holy Communion**

- ❖ The priest will put on a face mask & wash his hands.
- No distribution of Precious Blood at this time.
- Holy Communion will be distributed by rows; please wait to enter the aisle and stand 6 feet apart by using the tape on the floor as a guide.
- Face mask must be worn. Holy Communion will be distributed in the hand by the priest. DO NOT grab the Sacred Host from the priest (i.e., lay hands flat). Otherwise, re-sanitization of priest's hands will be necessary.
- ❖ After receiving communion in the hand, walk 6 feet away, remove mask, consume the Host, then re-mask & return to pew.
